Payment and Registration Policy:

Payment: Payment in the form of check, cash or credit card is required by September 13, 2010. Class size is limited to 10 students per class for pre-ballet; 15 students for all other classes. Early registration is suggested. **Recital:** A recital is planned for the end of May 2011. There will be an additional recital and costume fee. **Refunds:** If notification of cancellation for a class is received by September 1, 2010, all program fees will be refunded with the exception of a 10% handling fee. Refunds for cancellations received on and after September 1, 2010 will be granted under the following circumstances: The family is moving to another community; the child has a medical problem (please provide doctor's note); a three year old in the pre-ballet class is unable to adjust after a three class transition period. Refunds issued under these circumstances will be prorated for classes attended and will be subject to a 10% handling fee.
